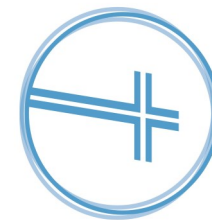

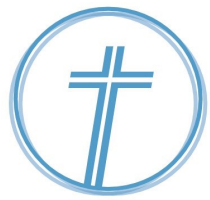

Reflections

He Will

I don't think it is possible to reach the seemingly bottomless barrel of catchy breakup songs: "Since U Been Gone" by Kelly Clarkson, "I Will Survive" by Gloria Gaynor, "Nothing Compares 2 U" by Sinéad O'Connor, "Before He Cheats" by Carrie Underwood, and so so so many more. Sorry if reading this gets one of them stuck in your head today! Those songs are usually from the perspective of one of two parties: the *break-er* or the *break-ee*. I turned on the radio for a moment recently and heard one from the *break-ee* that I'd never heard before: "Say You Will" by Fleetwood Mac.

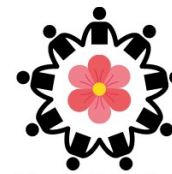
*"Say you will, say you will give me one more chance,
 At least give me time to change your mind.
 That always seems to heal the wounds..."*

There is no telling how many songs have lyrics roughly similar to those, but I'm certain there are quite a few!

As I have recently been teaching through Ezra/Nehemiah on Wednesdays, the attribute of God that is constantly being revisited is His **steadfast love**. Our approach to love and relationships is—with many hit songs as evidence—informed by a love riddled with failure, second chances, wounds, and the supposition "time heals all wounds."

I cannot help but compare that with what we see in the **steadfast, patient, long-suffering love of the Lord**. We are not loved by a God from whom we must request second chances or who keeps a daily outstanding account of our failures and wounds we inflict on Him. **There is no daily outstanding account of wounds, but there was an eternal one.** And those wounds could not be healed by time, but only through a person: "by his wounds we are healed" (Is. 53:5).

Fleetwood Mac sang about one whose love had been lost in the hopes of their lover receiving them back. **But our Lord's love will never be lost and He will always receive His own. He will.**
