

Hand and Heart

Over the Memorial Day holiday weekend, my family got the opportunity to get away and visit my parents for a few days. The visit wasn't unique, as we take a trip to see them from time to time. What was unique is that we stayed there for a Sunday, which meant we got to worship with my parents at their church. It has been years since this pastor got to sit under the preaching of that pastor (my father).

I try to take away one big thing when I'm on the other side of the pulpit, and I wanted to share that one big thing with you in this month's *Monthly Manna*.

My father concluded his sermon with an illustration of a man going through a family tragedy that left him questioning God and confused by His plan considering the suffering he was now undergoing. As my father told the story, he ended it with a quote by another pastor who has long been with Jesus, Charles Spurgeon. This was the quote:

"God is too good to be unkind, and He's too wise to be mistaken. And when we cannot trace His hand we must trust His heart."

You may have recently, are currently, or perhaps will soon face difficult days, days in which you question God or are confused by his plan. You may wonder why he has permitted such suffering in your life. Please hear this: even if you cannot trace God's hand, will you trust His heart?


