A few days ago I got the dreaded notification from my bank that none of us ever wants to receive: "FreeMsg: Banking Fraud Ctr: Did you attempt \$____ at ____ with card xxxxx?" Of course, the answer was no, which got me this lovely message in return: "FreeMsg: Fraud Ctr: Thank you. Your card is temporarily locked."

The silver lining was that I was thankful for how prompt my bank was to notify me immediately, limiting damages and canceling the card...At least that's what I thought!

It was the fifth of such charges, four of which had already gotten through. At least they "promptly" sent a new card—is anything "prompt" via snail mail?

Our lives are riddled with attacks ranging from minor inconveniences to catastrophic events. The minor inconvenience above is of little consequence, but you and I have suffered and will suffer far worse. The little analogy above made me grateful for something: our Lord is prompt to our aid before, during, and after any and every attack we suffer.
