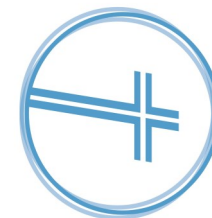

### Reflections

#### Childish Affections

With the recent addition of our newborn son Shepherd (and four kids six-and-under), parental demand is at an all-time high in the Hughes house. You may be the parent of a small child or of a grown child (but remember the “small” days well) or perhaps you’ve spent a few hours in the nursery with little ones. It does not take long for it to hit you: exhaustion.

I truly believe that there is something to be seen in every high and low that life has to offer—something that is meant to multiply our affections for our Father in heaven. These last few weeks, I am reminded that our Father is different than me. He has never felt exhausted—never over-demanded. He willfully responds to the call of, not three or four children, but millions across the globe (Ps. 17:6; 34:17). My weakness as a parent reveals a temper, lack of self-control, or bad attitude, but I am reminded that even when I am at my worst (my inner toddler), the Father is patient, kind, and steadfastly loving.

But also through the lens of children, there is something to be seen—something meant to multiply our affections for the Father. My children will one day grow up and increasingly function independent of me (and no more diapers and rocking to sleep!), but the Christian life is opposite. The more we grow into maturity in Christ, the **less** independent we realize we must become. Jesus would have us approach him **more and more** like dependent children, not **less and less**. “...But Jesus said, ‘Let the little children come to me and do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of heaven.’” (Matt. 19:14). Jesus wasn’t saying *only* kids are allowed in His Kingdom; he was endorsing in us all—young and old—the dependent spirit of a child.

We need our Father. We depend on His care in every way. The more we come to know it, the nearer to our Father we will become.
