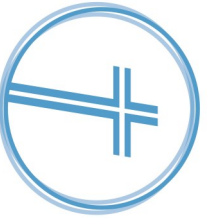

Reflections

A United Kingdom

Last month marked the end of the second longest lasting monarch ever recorded. Queen Elizabeth II occupied that position for over 70 years. Her funeral was capped at 2,000 people, but—and this is staggering—it was watched on television by 21 million people (in the UK alone, not to mention in international countries)! There were also thousands that physically paid their respects at her visitation (so many that street blocks were shut down and eventually no more entrants were permitted to the queue).

As stunning as it is that such a life can be lived and so many millions be impacted, Queen Elizabeth was no more fearfully and wonderfully made than any of us. While it is certainly fitting to honor individuals for their imprints on society and their character behind closed doors, it is also fitting to be reminded that at the end of the day, we are all in the same condition: finite creatures.

While I watched the events surrounding the end of a special life, my mind shifted to another Monarch, One whose reign is not finite but is infinite, One whose funeral wasn't attended by millions, not by thousands...not even by more than a handful. Yet whose reign lives on.

One day, the United Kingdom will reach its end, but there is a Kingdom of glory that will forever be united, not under a flag or tradition, but under a cross and empty grave. Our King's return will be ushered in by myriads upon myriads.

While it is fitting to carry around the reminder that all of us will one day reach our "end," we can take comfort knowing that because our King reigns, we will never reach the end.
