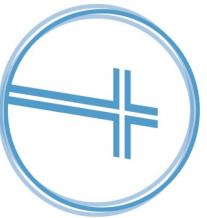

Reflections

A Different Kind of Hope

Hope. There are a couple of ways to understand that word. You may *hope* your team hoists a trophy at season's end. You may *hope* you ace that next test. You may *hope* the kids don't get the flu. You may *hope* the economy bounces back in 2023. All of these "hopes" have something in common: **uncertainty**.

But when the Bible speaks about hope, it does so not with **uncertainty** but with **certainty**. After days and days of rain, your *hope* is that it will one day cease (it will). After a cold winter, you may *hope* that it will be warm again one day soon (it will). After a long work week, your hope may be that the weekend is coming (it is). You see, your hope on the grim, dark days is that the dawn of a new day's light *will* come.

For the believer, our hope is not uncertain, but certain...

1 Peter 1:3-4 — Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! According to his great mercy, he has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, to an inheritance that is imperishable, undefiled, and unfading, kept in heaven for you.

Revelation 21:4 — He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away.

Perhaps you find yourself longing for hope. Be reminded today that if you are in Christ, your hope is not like that of an uncertain economy but that of an approaching certain dawn of a new day.
