

## **Reflections**

#### **Our Sustainer**

To *sustain* something is to give it strength, protection, comfort, to uphold it when it would otherwise collapse. God's sustaining work transcends anything any human can do. He is our Sustainer.

We have a coffee bar in the Hughes home (pictured below). A little caffeine can go a long way as a mother of four small children or as the pastor of a church so perfect, completely free from difficulty or problems—read as much sarcasm as you'd like! :) The point is that whatever joys, tests, or difficulties your everyday life holds, a little coffee, chocolate, sweet tea, etc. can be a bit of a sustainer! But it must be secondary.

I was making a cup of coffee recently and I noticed a heaping helping of irony. On the coffee bar sits a small picture frame that reads, "*He will sustain you. Isaiah 46.*" Now that's a funny phrase to place right beside **two coffee machines!** 

In that passage, God is reminding his people, "...I have made, and I will bear; I will carry and will save. To whom will you liken me and make me equal, and compare me, that we may be alike?" (Is. 46:4-5). The rhetorical answer is no one! Coffee can provide a helpful boost, but receive this reminder today: there is no daily help like our God.

"Behold, God is my helper; the Lord is the upholder of my life," (Ps. 54:4). "Cast your burden on the Lord, and he will sustain you; he will never permit the righteous to be moved," (Ps. 55:22).

If you are in Christ, cast your burdens before the Lord. He can handle <u>them</u>, and he loves <u>you</u>. A little coffee doesn't hurt either! On the other side of our coffee bar is a little placard that reads: "All I need today is a little bit of coffee and a whole lot of Jesus." Amen!
