

### **Wrecking Ball**

Lately I've been in Kings/Chronicles in my personal Bible reading. If you've spent a little time there, you quickly pick up on a pattern with the revolving door of kings of Israel/Judah. It goes something like this: "In the year of , [name] began to rule [Israel/ Judah]. He did what was [evil/right] in the eyes of the LORD." Normally, it is then followed by a peculiar statement. The author crucially tells the reader whether or not that king tore down the "high places" or left them standing (this is also why the Temple was built on Mt. Zion, the highest place in Jerusalem!). "High places" were altars constructed to false gods (Asherah, Baal, etc.). Why was this such a big deal? Because it was a big deal to God!!

Exodus 20:3 "You shall have no other gods before me."

To God's subsequent faithful people, it ultimately did not matter how much health, wealth, prosperity, children, possessions, etc. one had. At the end of the day, our ultimate lasting legacy is who/what we worshiped with our lives.

You may not have have entered this world with an altar or monument beside your infancy crib, but from a very young age, we build "high places" that compete with exclusive worship of God only. The altar of "self" is one we are constantly called to deconstruct and *tear down*, so that we can be a bodily temple devoted solely unto God.

1 Corinthians 6:19-20 Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God? You are not your own, for you were bought with a price. So glorify God in your body.

Where do you have "high places" that you need to tear down? Where are you making God compete for your time, money, and love? In the name of Jesus, let's take a wrecking ball to the high places and lift high our conquering King who has laid waste to the wages of sin that we may dwell in the house of the Lord forever.
