



Big Gratitude for a Big God

Worship is the result of gratitude. It's why we gather on Sundays, it's why we sing, it's why we have the Lord's Supper, it's why we pray, and it's why we celebrate Thanksgiving.

It's always interesting to me to see people on social media, television personalities, celebrities, and a generally unbelieving society celebrating Thanksgiving. "Giving thanks" is not arbitrary; it is something we do when we receive something **from someone**. There is always a recipient to thanksgiving. For an atheist to be thankful for the sun, trees, flowers, and gentle breeze makes no sense, because to them there is no recipient. It requires mental gymnastics for our godless culture to explain why exactly they celebrate Thanksgiving.

For us, there is stunning clarity to our gratitude. We celebrate Thanksgiving, because "every good and perfect gift is from above" (James 1:17). We "give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his love endures forever" (1 Chronicles 16:34). We "give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for [us] in Christ Jesus" (1 Thessalonians 5:16-18).

Thanksgiving is not just a day for family, friends, and food. It is a day for praise! So this month, as the anxiety of the holidays rapidly approaches, my prayer for you is that the volume of stress is vastly overcome by the volume of God's favor in your life. Ask God that this holiday season groveling would decrease and gratitude would increase.

At the dinner table tonight, we decided to go to three of the kids to see what *they* were thankful for.

Shiloh: Family, friends, our teachers, our food, what God has given us and all that he has made for us

Zion: All of the pretty trees, our family and friends, all of the fun toys and pretty flowers.
