# Reflections

## The Drop and the Bucket

Whenever something is very small in the grand scheme of things, we have a turn of phrase that you nay hear from time to time. "Oh, it's just a drop in a bucket." In a bucket full of water, a drop is so minuscule that it's hardly noticeable, extremely small in the grand scheme!

Funny enough, this phrase is one that can also be seen in Isaiah 40. Verse 15 reads, "Behold, the nations are like a drop from a bucket, and are accounted as the dust on the scales; behold, he takes up the coastlands like fine dust." Two verses later we read, "All the nations are as nothing before him, they are accounted by him as less than nothing and emptiness."

So small in comparison are the *nations* that they are like a drop in the bucket or dust on the scales (which doesn't even register on the scale!).

There are so many applications of these verses, but one that I'd like to leave with you today is that while your problems feel large, your circumstances feel insurmountable, your stressors feel overwhelming, our God—the giver of peace, comfort, refuge, and so much more—is bigger than them all. Literal empires and nations are nothing in comparison to him.

Take comfort, Fellowship family! God is as great as he is good!
