Kingdom Thinking, Kingdom Living

There are certain themes in God's Word that jump out above the rest. One of those is kingdoms/kings (there are literally books called 1 & 2 Kings!). You would be hard-pressed to find a principle in Scripture more important to God than that of seeing Him as our King and living lives that honor Him as such.


God was disappointed when his people demanded an earthly king (Saul) to be "like all the nations," (1 Sam. 8:5); He even said that such a demand meant they had rejected God "from being king over them," (1 Sam. 8:7). God felt provoked, and when his people's plan of a human king backfired and their nation suffered, he asked them, "Where now is your king, to save you in all your cities?" (Hos. 13:10).

However, even in the error of their thinking, God promised that He would give them both a perfect human King while also ensuring that He was their only true King.

In the gospel of Matthew, the wise men approached Herod and asked, "Where is he who has been born king of the Jews?" (Matt. 2:2). Herod, feeling threatened by this newborn King, issued a manhunt to eliminate him (Matt. 2:13), not wanting to lose his own status as king. He was right to feel threatened! Jesus came to reign and not share that reign. As Jesus began his earthly ministry, He proclaimed, "The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel," (Mk. 1:15).

But Jesus made it clear that his kingdom was "not of this world," (Jn. 18:36). It is no wonder, then, that the new testament calls Christfollowers sojourners (temporary stayers), ambassadors (representatives of a foreign nation/kingdom), and exiles (people away from their home). Christian, we are just passing through!

Do not seek to live life here "like the nations." Live for the kingdom and King that await you.
