

Barriers and Bridges

In the garden of Eden, the tragic result of Adam and Eve's sin is that they were barred from Eden, from the tree of life, and from the presence of God. Throughout the Old Testament, "separation" is woven throughout the biblical story.

Israel was separated from other peoples. Israel was also separated from God. At the same time, God wanted to be with his people. In the Tabernacle (huge tent of worship) and Temple (huge building of worship), respectively, there were special rooms that represented the dwelling place of God. Sure enough, there was a barrier (curtain/veil) separating people from those rooms—separated from God.

Isaiah 59:1–2 — 1 Behold, the Lord's hand is not shortened, that it cannot save, or his ear dull, that it cannot hear; 2 but your iniquities have made a separation between you and your God, and your sins have hidden his face from you so that he does not hear.

Desiring to be with His people but also knowing the holy/unholy separation problem, Jesus (Immanuel, God with us), entered the biblical story to restore and reconcile that which was broken

Matthew tells us that when Jesus gave up his spirit and breathed his last, completing the saving work he came to accomplish, "...the curtain of the temple was torn in two, from top to bottom," (Matt. 27:51). The 60-foot barrier between God and man was torn, not from bottom to top by man, but from top to bottom by God himself.

Later, in Ephesians 2, Paul visits another barrier overcome by the gospel, the social barriers between people.

Ephesians 2:13–14, 16 — But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far off have been brought near by the blood of Christ. For he himself is our peace, who has made us both one and has broken down in his flesh the dividing wall of hostility...and might reconcile us both to God in one body through the cross, thereby killing the hostility.

Our God is marvelous for many reasons; He is passionate about many things. But one thing that cannot be overstated is that he is passionate about putting back together, in love, that which has been broken. And we are to be passionate about the same thing.

2 Corinthians 5:18-18 All this is from God, who through Christ reconciled us to himself and gave us the ministry of reconciliation.

Don't be a barrier person. Be a bridge person.
