

# Reflections

## The Guiding Principles of the Heart

When we say someone is "acting on conviction," what we tend to mean is that they are guided by a deep set of guiding principles (no matter what consequences or outside influences may potentially sway).

As believers, God and His Word are to be the source of our deepest convictions—our guiding principles. There are many biblical examples that we can look toward. One of my favorites is a pagan fortune-teller named Balaam. Typically when you hear that name, the first biblical story that comes to mind is a talking donkey (No, really, look it up in Num. 22:22-41!). But there is another story in Balaam's life that is less visited but shouldn't be lost on us!

In Numbers 24, Balak, King of Moab, summons the pagan prophet Balaam to come speak a word of blessing over his kingdom. Balak even says that he knows that whomever Balaam blesses is blessed and whomever Balaam curses is cursed (Num. 22:6). That means you could take it to the bank! Balak wanted Balaam's blessing to secure a military victory over Israel.

The long story short is that God tells Balaam to **only tell Balak the very things he hears from the living God**. After Balaam agrees, he gives Balak the bad news: Moab, not Israel, would suffer defeat. After a few "back-and-forths" in which Balak demands a blessing rather than a curse, Balaam gives us our principled message:

Numbers 23:11-12 - 11 And Balak said to Balaam, "What have you done to me? I took you to curse my enemies, and behold, you have done nothing but bless them." 12 And he answered and said, "Must I not take care to speak what the Lord puts in my mouth?"

Numbers 23:26 — 26 But Balaam answered Balak, "Did I not tell you, 'All that the Lord says, that I must do'?"

Today, you will be prompted to speak, act, and feel in one of two ways: in a way that brings honor to self or in a way that brings honor to the Lord. **Your actions are a stream that flow from the spring of your heart**. What guiding principles are in your heart?

My prayer for you today is that you would be able to respond to those prompts the way Balaam did: *All that the Lord says, I must do.*
