

My Sinners' Prayer

A habit I have is writing a short Scripture-based prayer in a journal of mine. I wanted to share what I wrote 12/24/2024 as I reflected on my reading from Revelation 1.

Father, nothing is hidden from you. Not only are the hairs on your head white as fine wool—your wisdom (Rev. 1:14), but the words of your mouth are a flame of fire—your flawless judgment (Rev. 1:14-15). They pierce bone, marrow, and soul (Rev. 1:16). What could be hidden from you? You know all thoughts, actions, feelings, etc. This chapter is a terrifying reminder of the King's all-seeing gaze, but I am at the same time reminded that this is the same King who died and was raised for sinners. I am amazed by your grace and mercy—your lovingkindness—because you <u>DO</u> see me (ALL of me), and you still love me (ALL of me). For the glory of God, amen.

I share this short prayer because I pray it for you as much as I pray it for myself. It is true that God is righteous judge, and it is also true that God is loving Father. It *does not* mean that he loves our sin; it *does* mean that he loves us in spite of our sin.

He sees you fully for all that you are. Every ounce of that which separates you from Him is known by Him. What a scary thought! How much more, then, does it say about his **grace** that even in that knowledge, he sent His Son to die for your death and be raised for your eternal life?

On your best day, you are loved by God. On your worst day, you are loved by God. That is a King who is easy to love in return.
