Reflections

A Father's Love and Discipline

I've been told by many people (especially my bride!) that I say many words without saying any words at all, because of the faces I make! If something funny happens, but you don't want to laugh, then don't make eye contact with me! Growing up, when my siblings would get in trouble, I'd have to hide my face so I didn't get in trouble too. Sometimes when I'm reading my Bible. I find myself making faces as if I'm a fly on the wall in the same room as the situation I'm reading about.

In Jeremiah 5, the prophet Jeremiah is speaking the words of God to a wantonly arrogant and disobedient people—God's people. They had rejected the God who loved them unwaveringly, and instead had turned to false gods who had no power or love in them at all. Despite God's ongoing warnings of discipline, the climax of this rejection is in verse 12:

"They have spoken falsely of the Lord and have said, 'He will do nothing; no disaster will come upon us, nor shall we see sword or famine."

My paraphrase of the above is that they said God was full of it; He was bluffing. Can you imagine the righteous anger, the burning wrath, the sadness, and the disappointment of the

The result was discipline. God would send a foreign nation to take them into captivity—a seventy-year severe "time out" to make them think about what they had done, and specifically the hurt that they had brought to their Father. The aim: not destruction, but re-

As a fly on the wall, I read this passage with wide-eyed "Ooooo" and "You're in trouble now." The tone of my heart is that I cannot believe people could be so dismissive of God. But then it hits me: isn't that what we do every day? In response to God's love and what he says about how much he hates sin, we cross the line as if to say, "I know what he says, he will do nothing; no disaster will come upon us." It may not be verbatim Jeremiah 5:12, but it's in the same realm!

All of that said, there is one more thing we can identify with when it comes to God's discipline toward us. A few verses later, as the Father is outlining how he will discipline his people, God says this in verse 18:

"But even in those days, declares the Lord, I will not make a **full** end to you."

You and I will constantly (and thankfully) be corrected by God; sometimes, it may be painful. But if we are in Christ, we will never bear the full brunt of His wrath. Why? Because Jesus already did that.

Instead of making a "full end" to you and me, He made a full end to our sin, and that makes me do more than just make faces! He's worthy of every word of praise we could ever utter.
