



Aflame

In the last month, we have been able to receive two groups back home from extended stays with what we've called "debriefings" of the things God did and displayed to those who went. One group was our missions team that was sent out to minister to the people of Eswatini, Africa. The other was our students and leaders, who went to Arise Camp in Chattanooga, Tennessee. Both came back with their reports and "debriefed" their church family.

I decided to use this week's Monthly Manna entry to spotlight those two mission debriefings; God is doing so much in and through our church family!

As I sat and listened to the students debrief. I was stunned to hear the way they spoke about the Spirit's movement in their minds and hearts. I don't know about you, but I was not talking like they were when I was in middle/high school! It is easy for us to exist so much in the day-to-day that we never zoom out and examine the fruit of longevity (looking back) and the trajectory of the fruit of longevity (looking forward). The momentum of the flame of the Spirit of God in our young people is something all of us should 1) celebrate aloud, and 2) praise God for! Have you done these things lately? As I participated in the Africa debriefing, I found myself struggling to find the word to adequately communicate what God showed us across the Atlantic. In fact, I sat on a long bus ride across the South Africa border asking myself how I could say the perfect words to get my church family excited about our partnership overseas. But it has since hit me: at the end of the day, my words are not the flame, the Spirit of God is the flame. I trust that as we are faithful, obedient, vocal, worshipful, present, and missional, God will spread that flame in ways that myself, our mission team, students, and our leadership cannot.

In the infamous "on this Rock" passage directed from Jesus to Peter, there are easy to miss words that I want to emphatically place in front of you as I close (with bold underlines):

"And I tell you, you are Peter, and on this rock I will build my church. and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it."

- Matt. 16:18

God will do what you and I cannot. Let's join the mission, celebrate fruit aloud, and praise God for what he's done and what he's doing.
