





The Light of the World

For this month's entry, I was inspired by my reading in my advent devotional book. Day 1 of 25 of *Recapturing the Glory of Christmas* by Dr. Albert Mohler gave heavy emphasis to the role of light in the Christmas season.

My children "light up" when we are driving at night in December. Houses that they would normally not give a moment's glance suddenly become a spectacle—even from a great distance! Isn't that what Christmas lights do? While they are not easily observed or admired in the daylight, darkness has a way of heightening the illuminating presence of light.

Isn't that a wonderful picture of the gospel? I believe that is why the motif of light/darkness is so prevalent in the gospel of John.

"In him was life, and the life was the light of men. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it."

— John 1:4-5 —

The wonders of Christmas are powerfully seen—just like Christmas lights—in contrast to the spiritual darkness that we would be in without Christ. Like those beautiful spectacles we enjoy on the side of the road, as we walk through the valley of the shadow of darkness, we not only easily observe the Light, but we are also able to *admire* Christ, the light of the world, the light of life.

This Christmas, my prayer is that when you see lights in dark places and as your eyes are drawn to them, that you would be reminded that so too should your eyes be drawn to the presence of Jesus in the dark places of this life. There are glories of Jesus to behold this Christmas season. Are you looking for them? And if this holiday season feels especially dark for you, I urge you to consider that the Light should be especially visible for you this Christmas perhaps more than all the rest.

I hope you have a merry Christmas, but when it doesn't feel that way, remember that the Light has come but is also coming.
