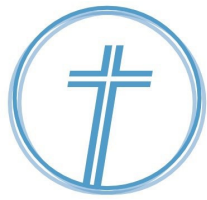

## Reflections

### No Rival, No Equal

Over the weekend, we sat down with the kids to watch a movie that I loved growing up: "The Prince of Egypt." It follows the story of Moses' life, emphasizing his coming to understand that he is not Egyptian but is Hebrew and climaxing with the liberation and exodus of God's people from Egyptian oppression.

I always am interested to see what captures our children's imagination and intrigue, especially in TV/movies. The scene that really seemed to resonate with one of our children was when Moses enters into Pharaoh's hall and demands that he let the Hebrews go. Moses's staff then turns into a serpent, prompting Pharaoh's "magicians" to conjure their own incantation to rebuttal the work of Moses's God. The scene then becomes a song sung by the two Magicians.

In the song, there is a moment when they call upon the power of around twenty Egyptian gods and goddesses. Our child asked us what they were saying (the names were not registering), so I explained that the Egyptians called upon their many gods in response to Moses calling on his one God. My son's eyes got large. "But" I assured him, "all of Egypt's gods are nothing and even all together they cannot rival the power of Moses's one true God, our God, the living God."

On the heels of Easter, it is important that we understand that the world will throw at us all of its power, influence, agendas, disdain, frustration, anger, etc. at our commitment to our God. It may at times feel like it is all we can do to keep our heads above water. But it is as important now as it was then, that we remember the Word of God:

*"The Lord will fight for you, and you have only to be silent." - Exodus 14:14*

*"And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus." - Philippians 4:10*

*No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. For I am sure that neither death nor life, nor angels nor rulers, nor things present nor things to come, nor powers, nor height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord." - Romans 8:37-39*

Our God has no rival, no equal. Rest in that today, especially when the enemy attacks.
