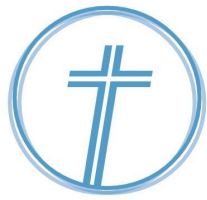

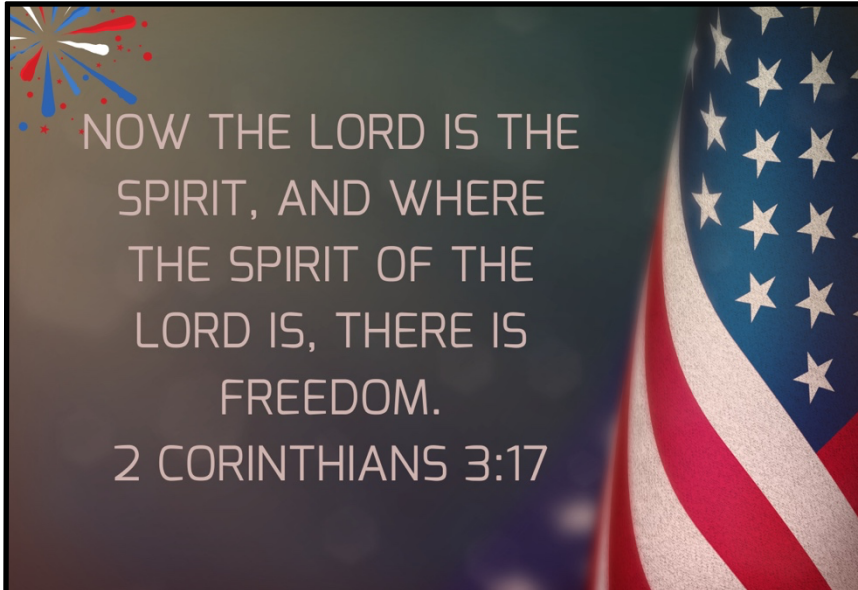

A Win Worth Nothing

I normally do not write about a subject like the one you will read below, but I believe that since it represents a major shift in the cultural movement, I believe it is important that we all know and celebrate it.

Recently, the ongoing debate concerning biological males, who identify as transgender females, participating in girls' and women's sports reached a pivotal crossroads. In West Virginia and Idaho, as a result of so-called transgender athletes petitioning for the permission to participate in girls'/women's sports, arguments were brought to the U.S. Supreme Court to determine the direction of the first domino of whether the transgender ideology would continue to steamroll sanity or if the movement would finally meet much-needed resistance.

- On June 30, the U.S. Supreme Court, in a 6-3 decision down party lines, upheld state laws in Idaho and West Virginia that restrict biological males from participation in girls' and women's school sports.
- The decision was 6-3.
- The Court held that Title IX and the U.S. Constitution permit states to limit girls' and women's sports to biological females.
- Though the ruling does not create a nationwide ban on transgender athletes in girls' or women's sports, the decision is expected to strengthen similar laws already enacted in more than two dozen states and will likely influence future litigation over transgender participation in school athletics.

Why should we as believers care about this? Because it potentially represents a cultural moment of sanity, recovering the value of girlhood, womanhood, and God's design for his creation. We should celebrate when the truth is no longer changed for a lie (Rom. 1).

While this debate is far from over, we as believers should celebrate the countless girls and women who will be positively impacted by this decision.

What now? We pray. Pray for God to use the decision to accomplish much more than a few Supreme Court judges are able. Pray for a rediscovery of the preciousness of girls being created to become God-fearing women. Pray for momentum. Pray for the Church to be the light of the world and a lighthouse for lost people seeking refuge and harbor.
